- Overall Grade point average of 2.5 or better (current transcript or report card)
- Demonstrate Hartage family relations
- Essay 250 words* on foundation topics.
- Strong volunteer/charitable service record
- Participation in school leadership activities and/or extra-curricular programs
- Two (2) Letters of recommendation (choose two of the following)
 - Church Leader (submit on church letterhead)
 - High School Counselor (submit on high school letterhead)
 - Teacher (submit on high school letterhead)
 - o Hartage Family member other than biological parents

This year's essay topic: What being a member of the Hartage Legacy means to me and why I am pursuing a future in STEM, Science, Technology, Engineering or Math. Or What being a member of the Hartage Legacy means to me and why I am pursuing college in my chosen field.



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Essays must be typed and double-spaced, 12-point font and must include the following information:

- 1. Student's name, address, telephone number, email address, school and GPA.
- 3. Essays of 250 words in length.
- 4. Essays will be judged on relevance to required topic, content and grammar.
- 5. Students with disabilities may request alternate essay and submission formats.
- 6. Winners will be notified by mail and awarded at the family reunion.

Complete instructions are included on the Hartage Family Website. All completed applications and requested documents must be received by: **5:00 p.m. Friday, May 10, 2019**. Applications may be submitted online through the Hartage Family website or by mail. Online applications must be submitted on or before the deadline.
